This casual sweater is knitted in Scrumptious DK/Worsted silk and merino luxury yarn.



Needles and accessories

1 set US size 6 [4mm/UK 8] circular needles, 24in [60cm] or longer
1 set US size 3 [3mm/UK 11] circular or double-pointed needles
Optional: 1 set US size 6 [4mm /UK 8] double-pointed needles for the sleeves
Stitch holders
Stitch markers

Tension

22 sts and 30 rounds to 4in [10cm] over stockinette stitch using US size 6 needles
30 sts and 26 rounds to 4in [10cm] over fisherman's rib using US size 6 needles

Abbreviations

K: Knit
K1b: Knit the next st in the row below
LH: Left-hand
meas: Measure(s)/measuring
P: Purl
PFB: Purl into front and back of the same stitch
pm: Place marker
rep: Repeat(s)/repeating
RH: Right-hand
RS: Right side
slm: Slip marker
st(s): Stitch(es)
WS: Wrong side

Pattern notes

This sweater is knitted in the round. The body and sleeves are worked separately and then joined together to complete the raglan yoke.

Please choose whether to follow the metric or imperial instructions, and use these throughout. The two sets of measurements give very marginally different finished lengths.

Yarn

Fyberspates Scrumptious DK (45% silk, 55% merino; 100g skeins)
Slate (109) 5 (6, 6, 7, 8) x 100g skeins

Body

Using US size 6 needles, cast on 188 (212, 236, 256, 280) sts. Join to work in the round, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for start of round.

Round 1: *K2, P2; rep from * to end of round.

Last round sets 2x2 rib. Work in 2x2 rib until piece meas 1 (1½, 1¾, 2, 2) in [3 (4, 4.5, 5, 5) cm] from cast-on edge.

Next round: Purl.

Last round sets reverse stockinette stitch. Work straight in reverse stockinette stitch until piece meas 16½ (17, 17½, 18) in [42 (43, 43, 44.5, 46) cm] from cast-on edge.

Next round: P8 (9, 9, 10, 11), then put the previous 16 (18, 18, 20, 22) sts onto a holder for the right underarm (this will be the sts just worked, plus the same number of sts from the previous round), P94 (106, 118, 128, 140), then put previous 16 (18, 18, 20, 22) sts onto a holder for the left underarm, P78 (88, 100, 108, 118). 78 (88, 100, 108, 118) sts remaining for each of Back and Front. Place sts on a holder.

Sleeves

Cast on 44 (48, 48, 52, 52) sts using US size 6 needles. Join to work in the round, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for start of round.

Work in 2x2 rib as set for Body until piece meas 1 (1½, 1¾, 2, 2) in [3 (4, 4.5, 5, 5) cm] from cast-on edge.

*Purl 8 (8, 6, 5, 4) rounds.

Next round: P1, PFB, purl until 2 sts before end of round, PFB, P1.

Repeat from * 12 (12, 16, 17, 20) more times. 70 (74, 82, 88, 94) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 17½ (18, 18¼, 18¼, 18¼) in [44.5 (45.5, 46.5, 46.5, 46.5) cm].

Next round: P8 (9, 9, 10, 11), then put previous 16 (18, 18, 20, 22) sts onto a holder for the underarm (this will be the sts just worked, plus the same number of sts from the previous round). Place rem 54 (56, 64, 68, 72) sts on a holder, and make a second sleeve in the same way.

Join for raglan yoke

Join sleeves and body as follows, using a single US size 6 circular needle: P78 (88, 100, 108, 118) Back sts, P54 (56, 64, 68, 72) from first sleeve, P78 (88, 100, 108, 118) Front sts, P54 (56, 64, 68, 72) from second sleeve. Place marker and join to work in the round. 264 (288, 328, 352, 380) sts. Purl 7 rounds.

The start of the round will be within the back right raglan "seam". Each raglan "seam" is 7 sts wide. Mark the four raglan seams as follows:

Next round: P4, pm, P70 (80, 92, 100, 110), pm, P7, pm, P48 (50, 58, 62, 66), pm, P7, pm, P70 (80, 92, 100, 110), pm, P7, pm, P48 (50, 58, 62, 66), pm, P3.

Next round: *P4, slm, P68 (78, 90, 98, 108), P2tog, slm, P7, slm, P46 (48, 56, 60, 64), P2tog, slm, P3; rep from * once more. 260 (284, 324, 348, 376) sts.

Round 1: *[P1, K1] twice, slm, [P1, K1] to last st before next marker, P1, slm, K1, P1, K1; rep from * 3 more times.

Round 2: *[P1, K1] twice, slm, [P1, K1b] to last st before next marker, P1, slm, K1, P1,

K1; rep from * 3 more times.

Last two rounds set rib at raglans, and fisherman's rib on Back, Front and Sleeves.

Work 2 more rounds as set.

Round 5 (dec): *P1, K1, slip next stitch (purl) to RH needle, swap positions of first and second sts on LH needle, taking second stitch from behind first stitch (leave marker between second and third sts on LH needle), return slipped stitch (purl) to LH needle, P2tog, K1, slm, work in fisherman's rib as set to last st before next marker, swap positions of first and second sts on LH needle, taking first st behind second st (moving marker to RH needle), K1, P2tog, K1; rep from * 3 more times. 8 sts dec.

Round 6: As round 2.

Work last 2 rounds 16 (16, 18, 18, 18) more times. 124 (148, 172, 196, 224) sts.

Change to US size 3 needles.

Work in rib as set for 2 more rounds without further shaping. Bind off loosely in rib.

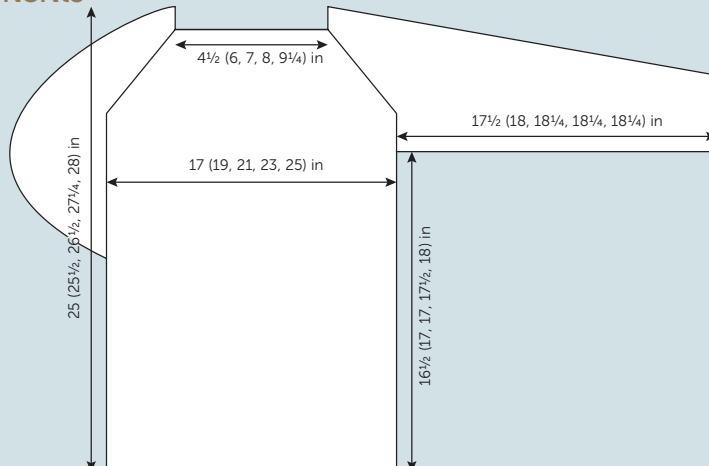
Making up

Slip sts at sleeve underarm to one needle, and slip sts at body underarm to another needle and graft the stitches together using Kitchener stitch. Alternatively the 3-needle bind-off method can be used.

Repeat for other underarm.

Weave in all ends and block gently to measurements, following yarn care instructions on the label.
