Yarn

Fyberspates Scrumptious Aran (45% silk, 55% merino; 100g skeins) 6 (6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9) x 100g skeins
Sample is shown in a shade that is no longer available. Teal Blue (406) and Water (403) are the closest current shades.

Needles and accessories

1 set US size 10 [6mm /UK 4] double-pointed knitting needles (DPNs)
1 set US size 8 [5mm /UK 6] circular needles (due to large number of stitches)
1 set US size 6 [4mm /UK 8] circular needles (due to large number of stitches)
Or needle sizes required to achieve gauge (see note)
Approx US size K/10.5 [6mm] crochet hook (exact size is not vital)
Small quantity of waste yarn (approx. worsted weight)
Press stud fastener
Shawl pin (optional)

Gauge

Gauge after washing and blocking (please don't omit washing the swatch)
17 sts and 22 rows to 4in [10cm] in stockinette stitch using US size 8 needles
17 sts and 32 rows to 4in [10cm] over Seed Stitch using US size 6 needles
17 rounds to 4in [10cm] over 3 stitch i-cord using US size 10 needles
17 sts and 22 rows to 4in [10cm] over 3x3 Rib using US size 8 needles
17 sts and 26 rows to 4in [10cm] over Texture Stitch using US size 6 needles

Abbreviations

K: Knit
P: Purl
st(s): Stitch(es)
RS: Right side
WS: Wrong side
rep: Repeat(ing)
ch: Crochet chain stitch
DPN: Double-pointed needle
Sl: Slip
wyib: With yarn in back
wyif: With yarn in front
fol: Follow(s)/following
alt: Alternate
SSK: Slip 2 stitches separately as if to knit, then knit these 2 stitches together through the back loops
rem: Remain(s)/remaining
dec: Decrease(s)/decreasing
inc: Increase(s)/increasing
st st: Stockinette stitch (UK stocking stitch)
w&t: Wrap and turn. Take yarn to opposite side of work, slip next st from left-hand to right-hand needle, take yarn back to working side, and return stitch to left-hand needle. Turn. When working back across wrapped sts, work the wrapped st and the wrapping loop together as one.
i-cord: Over 3 sts using a double-pointed needle: **Round 1:** K3 and slide sts to opposite end of needle. **All foll rounds:** Without turning, K3, pulling yarn firmly across back when you work the first stitch. Slide sts to opposite end of needle. Rep last round until sufficient rounds have been worked.

Pattern notes

Please choose whether to follow the metric or imperial instructions, and use these throughout. The two sets of measurements give very marginally different finished lengths.

Stitch patterns

SEED STITCH (UK MOSS STITCH)

Worked over 2 sts and 2 rows (US size 6 needles).

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2 (WS): *P1, K1; rep from * to end of row.

3X3 RIB

Worked over 6 sts and 2 rows (US size 8 needles).

Row 1 (RS): *K3, P3; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2 (WS): As row 1.

DOT STITCH

Worked over 4 sts and 8 rows (US size 8 needles).

Row 1 (RS): *K3, P1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 and all foll WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 5: K1, *P1, K3; rep from * to last 3 sts, P1, K2.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: As row 2.

TEXTURE STITCH

Worked over 2 sts and 4 rows (US size 6 needles).

Row 1 (RS): *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

Row 3: *P1, K1; rep from * to end.

Row 4: *P1, K1; rep from * to end.

GARTER DIAGONALS

Worked over 4 sts and 8 rows (US size 8 needles).

Row 1 and all foll RS rows: Knit.

Row 2 (WS): *K3, P1; rep from * to end.

Row 4: *K2, P1, K1; rep from * to end.

Row 6: *K1, P1, K2; rep from * to end.

Row 8: *P1, K3; rep from * to end.

Jacket

I-CORD CAST-ON METHOD

Work a 7 ch using waste yarn and crochet hook.

Using main yarn and a US size 10 DPN, pick up and knit 3 sts in the bumps on the back of the crochet chain (ignore the first and last 2 sts).

Work 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) rounds of i-cord as explained in the Abbreviations section.

Carefully remove the crochet chain at the start of the i-cord and using US size 6 circular needle, pick up the 3 sts revealed. Then pick up (but don't knit) 1 st in each round of the i-cord, following a straight column of stitches. Slide the final 3 sts of i-cord onto the circular needle. 106 (106, 106, 112, 112, 116, 116, 120) sts (3 sts from each end of i-cord plus 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts picked up from edge of i-cord).

Left front

Row 1 (RS): K3 (pulling firmly when working first stitch to bring i-cord edge round), work Seed Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, take yarn to back of work and Sl 3 sts purlwise.

Row 2 (WS): P3 (pulling firmly when working first stitch to bring i-cord edge round), work Seed Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, bring yarn to front of work and Sl 3 sts purlwise. These 2 rows set Seed Stitch with built-in i-cord edges. Work a further 42 rows in seed st with built in i-cord as set.

Row 45: K3 (i-cord sts), work Texture Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 sts purlwise wyib.

Row 46: P3 (i-cord sts), work Texture Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 sts purlwise wyif. These 2 rows set Texture Stitch with i-cord. Work a further 30 rows as set.

Change to US size 8 circular needles.

Row 77: K3 (i-cord sts), work Dot Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 sts purlwise wyib.

Row 78: P3 (i-cord sts), work Dot Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 sts purlwise wyif. These 2 rows set Dot Stitch with i-cord. Work a further 4 (6, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28) rows as set.

SHAPE ARMHOLE

****Row 1 (RS):** K3, work Dot Stitch as set over 52 (50, 50, 52, 52, 52, 52, 54) sts, wrap next st and turn, leaving remaining sts unworked.

Rows 2, 4 and 6 (WS): Dot Stitch as set to last 3 sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.

Row 3: K3, Dot Stitch over 50 (48, 48, 50, 50, 50, 52) sts, wrap next st and turn.

Row 5: K3, Dot Stitch over 48 (46, 46, 48, 48, 48, 50) sts, wrap next st and turn.

Row 7: K3, Dot Stitch over 48 (46, 46, 48, 48, 48, 50) sts, bind off next 30 (32, 32, 34, 34, 36, 36, 38) sts, working wraps with sts as described above as you reach them, place final 25 (25, 25, 27, 27, 29, 29, 29) sts on a holder.

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to 51 (49, 49, 51, 51, 51, 53) sts and slip first st purlwise, then work Dot Stitch to last 3 sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.

Work 4 more rows on these 51 (49, 40, 51, 51, 51, 53) sts only, maintaining Dot Stitch and i-cord edging, and slipping first st on WS row to create firm armhole edge.

Row 13: K3, Dot Stitch over 48 (46, 46, 48, 48, 48, 50) sts, turn, cast on 2 sts. 53 (51, 51, 53, 53, 53, 55) sts.

Rows 14 and 16: Work Dot Stitch as set to last 3 sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.

Row 15: K3, Dot Stitch over 50 (48, 48, 50, 50, 50, 52) sts, turn, cast on 2 sts. 55 (53, 53, 55, 55, 55, 57) sts.

Row 17 (RS joining row): K3, Dot Stitch over 52 (50, 50, 52, 52, 52, 52, 54) sts, turn, cast on 26 (28, 28, 30, 30, 32, 32, 34) sts, join in 25 (25, 25, 27, 27, 29, 29, 29) held sts and work Dot Stitch over 22 (22, 22, 24, 24, 26, 26, 26) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyib.

Row 18: P3, Dot Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.**

Back

Work Dot Stitch with i-cord edges as set, over the next 23 (25, 27, 31, 35, 39, 43, 47) rows.

Next row (WS dec): P3, work in Dot Stitch and **at the same time** dec 4 (4, 4, 0, 0, 2, 2, 0) sts and inc 0 (0, 0, 2, 2, 0, 0, 0) sts evenly across next 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif. 102 (102, 102, 114, 114, 114, 114, 120) sts.

Next row (RS): K3, work 3x3 Rib over next 96 (96, 96, 108, 108, 108, 108, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyib.

Next row: P3, work 3x3 Rib over next 96 (96, 96, 108, 108, 108, 108, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.

These 2 rows set 3x3 Rib with i-cord. Continue as set for a further 25 rows.

Next row (WS inc): P3, work in 3x3 Rib and **at same time** inc 4 (4, 4, 0, 0, 2, 2, 0) sts and dec 0 (0, 0, 2, 2, 0, 0, 0) sts evenly across row, to last 3 sts, Sl 3 sts purlwise wyif. 106 (106, 106, 112, 112, 116, 116, 120) sts.

Next row: K3, work Dot Stitch over next 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyib.

Next row: P3, work Dot Stitch over next 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.

Work Dot Stitch with i-cord edges as set over next 22 (24, 26, 30, 34, 38, 42, 46) rows.

SHAPE ARMHOLE

Work as given from ** to ** of first armhole.

Right front

Work a further 6 (8, 10, 14, 18, 22, 26, 30) rows in Dot Stitch and i-cord edges as set.

Next row: K3, work Garter Diagonals Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyib.

Next row: P3, work Garter Diagonals Stitch over 100 (100, 100, 106, 106, 110, 110, 114) sts, Sl 3 purlwise wyif.

These 2 rows set Garter Diagonals Stitch with i-cord edging. Work a further 30 rows as set.

Change to US size 6 needles and work 41 rows in Seed Stitch and i-cord edging as set, ending with RS facing for next row. (Fronts should now match in length)



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I-CORD CAST-OFF

Using a US size 10 DPN, K2, SSK. *Slip 3 sts back to left needle, K2, SSK; repeat from * until 6 sts rem.

Graft these 6 sts together using Kitchener stitch.

Sleeves

Using US size 6 needles, cast on 36 (36, 38, 38, 40, 40, 42, 42) sts.

Next row: Knit.

Rep last row 7 more times.

Change to US size 8 needles.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Cont to work in st st, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and 9 (3, 3, 4, 4, 8, 8, 13) foll 8th (6th, 6th, 6th, 6th, 6th, 6th) row, then on every foll 0 (8th, 8th, 8th, 8th, 8th, 8th, 0) row to 56 (58, 60, 62, 64, 66, 68, 70) sts. Work 11 (9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 11) rows straight, ending with RS facing for next row.

SHAPE SLEEVEHEAD

Bind off 3 sts at the start of the next 2 rows. 50 (52, 54, 56, 58, 60, 62, 64) sts.

Work 2 rows straight.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row to 24 sts.

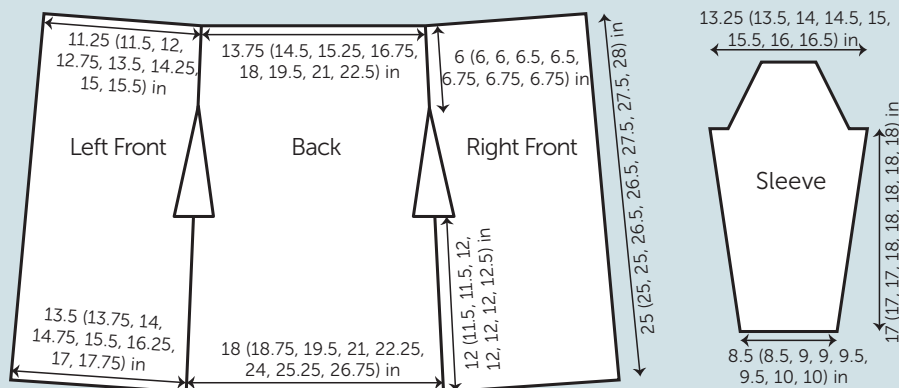
Work 1 row straight.

Bind off rem sts.

Finishing

Soak all pieces in lukewarm water for 20 minutes. Gently squeeze out water and press between towels to remove excess moisture. Pin out each piece to measurements and allow to dry fully. Sew sleeve seams and set-in sleeves. If desired, sew press stud to fasten top corner of Left Front to Right Front. Weave in all ends.
