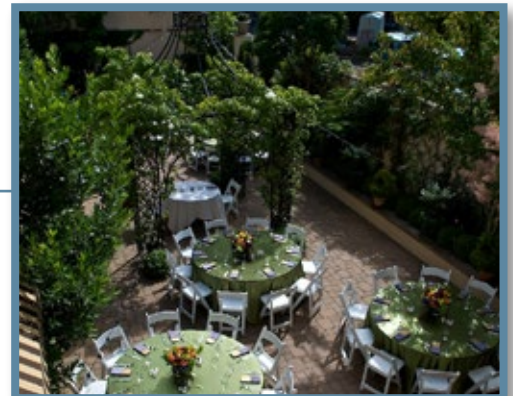

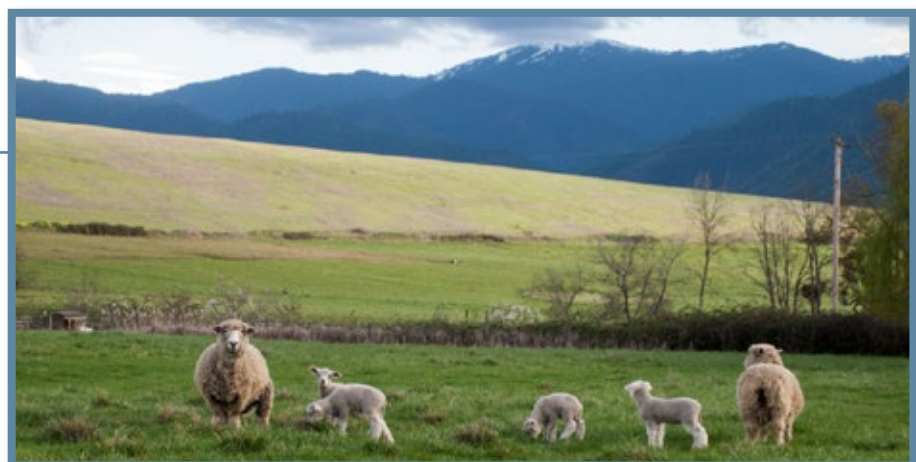
Above: English Garden, Below: Dona's Ranch

FRESH FAIR ISLE

Mary Jane Mucklestone

Mary Jane travels the world to study traditional knitting techniques and learn more about the history of the craft. She's a popular teacher specializing in lively, fun and informative classes. She's the author of 3 books featuring stranded colorwork, 200 Fair Isle Motifs and 150 Scandinavian Motifs, were instant classics and have been translated into many languages, while Fair Isle Style shares contemporary designs of hers and 17 of her designer friends. Geo Knits, her latest book, is celebration of geometric shapes and their place in fashion, design and knitting of course! It gets back to Mary Jane's knitting roots, exploring many techniques that seemed mysterious when she first learned to knit. She feels lucky to be invited to teach all over the world, and is eager to share knitting knowledge with her students. She aims to give students the courage to try something new!

Class Description:

Liven up your Fair Isle knitting! Spend the day exploring fresh new colorways. This intermediate level course will introduce the basics of color theory and how to use its principles to guide your color choices. We will learn about the use of color over the years in traditional Fair Isle knitting and move beyond, developing our own personal color schemes. We'll analyze how different color combinations can completely change how a motif looks. Knitting a simple stranded wristlet or fingerless glove will quickly illustrate new concepts.

Tif Fussell of *Dottie Angel*

Tif Fussell spent many moons and numerous years bringing up her clan in a mossy shed surrounded by critters and pine trees just outside of Seattle. On any given day she could be found blogging, crafting or writing books under the name of dottie angel. These days Tif is a little wiser and a little older. With children scattered around the globe she rekindled her love for embroidery, using rustic and hand dyed yarns to create 'woolly tattoos'. When Tif isn't plotting her next slow stitch, she can be found with her nose in a book, most likely on Buddhism or finding her chi through Qigong or working on her 'dottie angel' clothing patterns for Simplicity. So in a nutshell, Tif is a woolly tattoo artist, a crafty dabbler of sorts, a critter liker, a would-be, could-be Buddhist and definitely a little vintage most days.

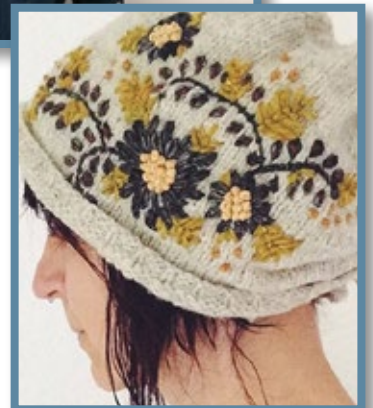
Class Description:

Learn some simple embroidery stitches to embellish your knits. We will be introduced to Tif's "tattooing" technique for making any knitted item a statement. We'll spend our time making some samples, and then create a floral "woolly tattoo" motif on a hat.
